The possible risks or discomforts of the study are minimal. You may feel a little uncomfortable or offended reading some of the tweets in the study, which are drawn from political Twitter conversations.

There are no direct benefits to you from participating in this study. However, your responses may help us learn more about how emotions are expressed online and how we may better resolve political polarization.

**As a token of our appreciation for completing the survey,** you will be paid for your time in the study. You will be paid a baseline of \$0.80 for participation in the study. If you do not pass any of the gold standard questions we have during the study, you will not be able to earn more than \$0.80. If you complete the entire study, you will earn an additional \$1.60 (up to \$2.40 total).

Your part in this study is anonymous to the researcher(s).
